

On Pointe Dance Centre Safety/Hygiene Protocol

As we re-open our doors to welcome our students for final classes before our performances, summer camps and summer classes, we will be adhering to the following protocol, based on compliance with our state requirements and recommended hygiene measures:

FACILITIES:

- Each class is capped at 11 students maximum. Each studio is capped at 12 people maximum, including students, instructors, and staff.
- There will be numbers on floor to help students with social distancing measures.
- Hand sanitizer will be used before and after each barre exercise.
- The lobby, classroom and bathroom will be disinfected after each class/camp, and at the beginning and end of each class/camp. This will include disinfecting all hard surfaces; door handles, mirrors, windows, acro mats.

ON POINTE DANCE CENTRE STAFF:

- All instructors, assistants and support staff will be given a temperature check when they arrive at the studio, ensuring they are well.
- All staff will perform a thorough hand washing at the start of every camp/class and use hand sanitizer during the camp/class as appropriate.
- Staff will always wear proper footwear in the studio, no bare feet allowed.
- Instructors will eliminate hand holding, touching and hugging from our classroom routine. "Air hugs and high fives" will become the new norm for now.
- Masks will not be required, leaving it to the personal discretion of the instructor.

STUDENTS & PARENTS:

- We will rely on parents to check the temperature of their child at home before leaving for the Studio. Of course, if your child has any signs of sickness, please keep them at home for a minimum of 72 hours.
- Students will be checked in and checked out at the Studio front doors by our staff. We ask that parents and siblings not enter the studio. Staff can and will walk students out to cars if necessary.
- Students will always wear proper footwear, no bare feet allowed.
- Masks will not be required, but students are welcome to wear one if they so choose.
- Snacks will be individually portioned out in advance and there will be no "self-serving" from bowls or trays. We ask that you child bring their own labeled water bottle to class and camp.
- Craft supplies will be individually packaged as well, and not shared between students. Any reusable items (scissors, markers, etc.) will be sanitized between camps.
